**Barbican Exhibition Hall 1 - Internal and external alterations to include the installation of new external facade cladding in lieu of existing and new plant equipment alterations for internal enabling works – 10/00876/FULLR3 – change of use**

I write on behalf of the Barbican Association to object in respect of the application to change the use of this building.

The Barbican Association does not object in principle to the location of cinemas in the exhibition hall. However, we believe this permission should be granted with conditions that will ensure the proposed use does not reduce the residential amenity enjoyed by Barbican residents.

We therefore propose the following conditions:

- 1) The public and anyone hiring the premises are not to be allowed on the premises between the hours of 23.15 and 07.00. (These are the times suggested by the applicant, see Barbican Cinema – Visitor Management Strategy Plan, p. 2.)
- 2) permission for the proposed A3 café and A3 restaurant must exclude the possibility of these retail units becoming pubs, winebars or similar operations where the business(es) are led by the sale of alcohol.

3) For the proposed A3 café and A3 restaurant, the public and anyone hiring the premises are not to be allowed in the café or restaurant between the hours of 23.00 and 07.00. (These are the times suggested by the applicant, see Barbican Cinema – Visitor Management Strategy Plan, pp. 2-3.)
